# Purposes of processing personal data

# The legal basis for the collection and processing of your personal data is:

In all other cases: that it is necessary for our legitimate interests, which are to build a programme to encourage participation in cricket and to ensure that the reputation of cricket is preserved, and this does not prejudice or harm your rights and freedom or those of parents / guardians of children and / or that it is necessary for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims. 9. Equality, diversity and inclusion (EDI): that you have given your explicit consent by answering the question(s).

# Your right to withdraw consent

Where you have given consent, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. If you or they do, it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing for which we had consent prior to you withdrawing it.

## Location of your personal data

We will normally keep your personal data within the United Kingdom or the European Economic Area.

#### How long we will keep your personal data for?

We will normally keep your personal data for two years after your last engagement with us. After this time period we will anonymise your information and keep for analysis of engagement trends.

Your rights in respect of your personal data

You have the right of access to your personal data and, in some cases, to require us to restrict, erase or rectify it or to object to our processing it, and the right of data portability.
